

Wall and Topic Posting Rules at Legalise Cannabis International

We are a serious international political umbrella group for advocates of cannabis law reform working together towards cannabis pro-legislation worldwide. We wish to maintain our Wall and Discussions to a high standard for all of our Members and it is for this reason we have posted this document. This document may be revised from time to time. If it is, it will be reposted on the Wall.

The Wall and Discussion Topics

Yes, all content is public – but always remember, please, that you are addressing our Group members. Comments such as "Wake Up" "Sheeple" etc are completely unacceptable. All posts that are deemed as being abusive, racist, sexist will be removed.

All posts that include mention of hard drugs or comparisons (safety or otherwise) of cannabis to any other substances, will be removed. We only do cannabis and cannabis legalisation – not cannabis advocacy or ideology.

All posts from, or on behalf of, shops, publications or book sales, dealers offering seeds etc, spammers and trollers will result in the member being banned from the Group.

All posts that include donation requests, other than requests approved by Admin **solely** to an Officer's legitimate political cannabis/hemp case, will be removed.

All **non-Officer** posts that include a personal web, blog or FB address will be removed.

We do not allow members to sell products on our site – irrespective of how good they sound. All Wall posts that include a commercial or promotional link, including book sales etc will be removed.

All posts that include bad language will be removed.

We don't do God. All religious references will be removed. Put them on your own Wall :-)

Discussion Topics – All of the above and:

All personalised posts on any discussion topic that include abusive, contentious or unfriendly direct address to the name/s of other posters on any topic will be removed. We do not have a forum. Please refrain from these kinds of direct address in your posts.

All posts that include non-cannabis politics on any discussion topic will be removed.

We often receive messages from new Group members telling us that they really like the serious political approach that our Group takes towards pro-legislation. The LCI Team agrees. This is what Legalise Cannabis International does and will continue to do.
